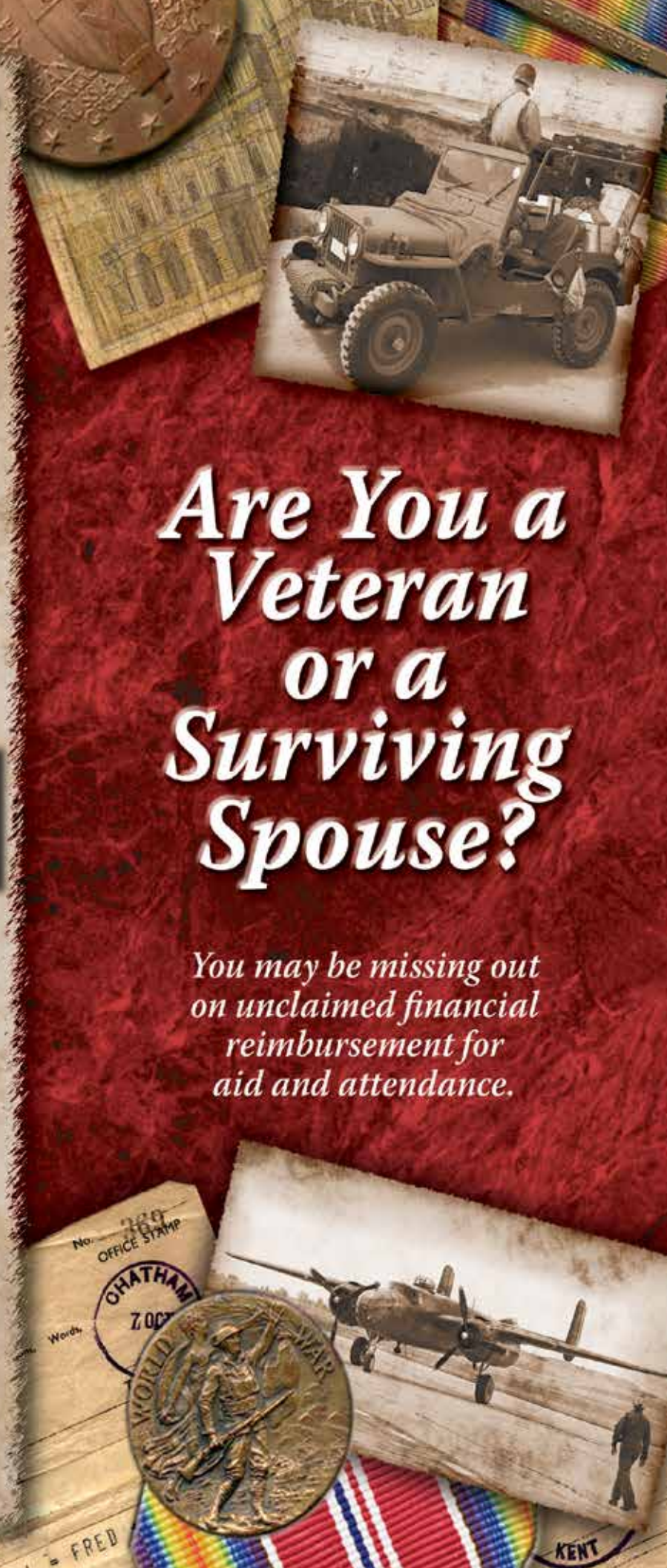

## Who Is Most Likely To Qualify?

Veterans and surviving spouses in assisted living, nursing facilities, or those receiving at-home care are most likely to qualify.

### Basic Qualifications

- Did the veteran serve in active duty for at least 90 days, with at least one day during a declared state of war?
- If you are a surviving spouse, were you married to the veteran at the time of his passing?
- Do you require the assistance of another person to perform daily activities of living?
- Are you paying for care that is now or will soon exceed your monthly income?
- Will care be needed on a permanent basis?

If you feel you may be eligible, then you owe it to yourself to find out if you may qualify for this little known, little used pension.

## Is This For Me?

### *How to Get an Aid and Attendance Rating*

In order to be qualified for Aid and Attendance, you will need to prove that you need assistance on a daily basis. There are many conditions that will be considered by the VA in determining this.

Some examples are:

- The need for assistance with bathing and other hygiene needs
- If you require supervision with daily living activities so as not to harm yourself or those around you
- The need for assistance with dressing, undressing and grooming

There are many other factors that may be considered in determining eligibility.
